

KS2 'un-validated' SATs Results July 2017

The following table reports the % of Year 6 pupils that attained Age Related Expectations (ARE) in the 2017 National Tests or attained 'above' Age Related Expectations (Higher Standard).

Number of pupils tested = 57 / 58 pupils

1 pupil was dis-applied from the tests. The results below are based upon the whole cohort of 58 pupils.

**N.B. as there is no National Writing Assessment Test, the writing is Teacher Assessment only*
