Bubble Change

From Monday Key stage 2 classes will operate as their own class bubble rather than a year group bubble. This decision has been taken in order to limit risk of transmission as well as to lessen the impact if there is a confirmed case. Children's routines will remain very similar to what they have experienced so far including the same amount of outdoor time etc. This is another measure we have taken in order to keep our school community as safe as we possibly can. EYFS and KS1 will continue as year group bubbles whilst continuing to adhere to all safety measures in place.
