Confirmed Covid-19 Case

Dear Parent or Carer,

We have been advised by Public Health England that there is a confirmed case of COVID-19 within our school community.

I would like to take time to reassure you that we have taken all necessary actions since hearing this information. The individuals affected are now self-isolating for 14 days and the school has been cleaned appropriately. The confirmed case does not affect any year group bubbles so children do not need to start isolation and should continue to attend as normal following the half term break (unless part of 3M bubble who must continue to isolate).

How to stop COVID-19 spreading

There are things you can do to help reduce the risk of you and anyone you live with getting ill with COVID-19

- \cdot wash your hands with soap and water often do this for at least 20 seconds
- \cdot use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available
- \cdot wash your hands as soon as you get home
- · cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze
- \cdot put used tissues in the bin immediately and wash your hands afterwards
