#### D&T

The Children will explore and evaluate a range of existing bird feeders then design and make their own suitable product.

#### Geography

In geography, we will be comparing a small area of the UK with a small area in a contrasting non-European country. We will compare the owls we have here in the UK and the owls abroad focusing on the climate differences.

# R.E

We be finding out how and why we celebrate special and sacred times.

## Science

The children will be learning about habitats. We will be Identifying and naming a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including microhabitats.



## **History**

We will be looking at a historical event beyond living memory -The Gun Powder Plot. We will sequence events and extend our speaking, listening and thinking skills through discussion and debate.
