## What's to come next term...

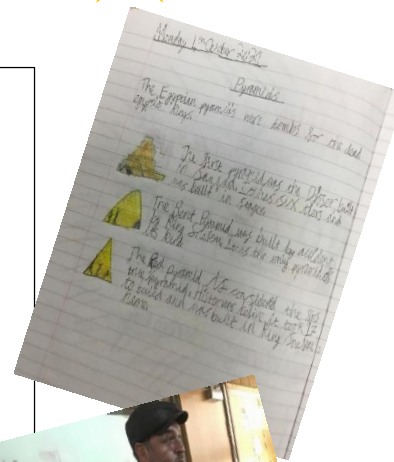
### EYFS

In early years this term we have begun looking at photos from the past.

We looked at photos of Jesse Owens and Usain Bolt and talked about which one we thought was an older picture.

### Key Stage 1

Key stage 1 this term has begun focusing on some of our key vocabulary in History. They have been looking at things that are old and things that are new. They have also been ordering 2 events on a timeline.



### Lower Key Stage 2

Year 4 have been completing an in depth study about life in Ancient Egypt. They have studied the timeline of key events of the time, looked at their daily lives and studied how they built the incredible pyramids.

### Upper Key Stage 2

Year 6 have been looking in detail at World War II. They have looked at the allies and axis forces. We were also very lucky to have a visit from an author who wrote books about his Grandad's experiences of living in World War II.



- In Early Years you will be seeing us continue to look at items from the past.
- In Key Stage One there will be a focus on the Gunpowder Plot and changes within living memory.
- Lower Key Stage Two will be continuing to develop their understanding of Ancient Greece and Ancient Egypt.
- Some of our upper Key Stage Two classes are working going to be looking at the rise and fall of the Maya civilisation.
