## Celebrating Autumn Term 2021

Come and take a peek at what's been going on...



**EYFS** Making the best of all the wonders that Autumn brings, our nursery children have been on number scavenger hunts in the wild garden. Reception children have been counting out a smaller number from a larger group. They used food from their kitchen to help subitise small quantities.



**KS1** Children have been using their knowledge of the properties of 2D shape to sort shapes into a Carroll Diagram. They have also been looking at units of measurement. They chose the appropriate standard unit of measurement to estimate and measure length and height.



**KS2** Class 4B have been using coloured straws to complete a problem solving and reasoning task. The children used their straws to see how many triangles and squares they could make. The challenge was to increase the amount of squares but with no extra straws! Year 5 have enjoyed using their knowledge of number to beat their partners in number strategy games using spinners.



**Hive** Children have been exploring 2D shape in the local environment and finding lines of symmetry. How many lines of symmetry does a square have?



**Maths Club** Children have been exploring circles in nature, playing countdown and multiplication bingo.
