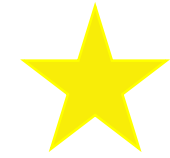




Hi! I'm Miss Nelson, lead in P4C (Philosophy for Children) here at **S.M.I.T.H**

EYFS

Nursery have been focusing on sharing and turn taking during their circle times.

Reception have loved their **parachute games**, where they have used a lot of 'Would you rather' questions.



Lower KS2

We've had some full enquiries going on in Year 3 and 4 so far this year. Year 3 held a silent debate in their classrooms, whereas Year 4 organised an **agree/disagree** line around their chosen topic.

Upper KS2

KS1
