Newsletter Spring Two 2022 A Warm Welcome Back Hedgehogs!





Firstly, I would like to thank all the parents for their warm welcome to nursery! I have enjoyed getting to know all the children in nursery.

Curriculum

During Spring 2 the children in Nursery will be exploring how things grow. We will explore the growth process of plants and animals including humans. We will be using the books below to deepen our knowledge and undersanding of growth in and animals. plants









We will be planting seeds to discover what they might turn into: will they be fruits, flowers or plants? The children will closely monitor the change and growth of animals as they document animal Life cyles.

Maths

In maths we will have a weekly magic number that we will be working on. We will focus on number recognition, number formation and counting up to ten. We recommend watching Numberblocks:

Phonics

The children will develop their listening skills by going on environmental walks, playing sound lotto games. They will also begin to explore Phonemes of the alphabet. As a School we follow the Monster Phonics scheme. Pleasse watch this short clip that supports the phomenes that we will be focusing on in nursery.

What is a phoneme?

A phoneme is the smallest unit of sound in a word.
