

Science

We will learn about the changes we go through as humans from birth to old age. We will also learn about the life cycles of living creatures including mammals, insects, birds and amphibians.

History

We will learn about the Early Islamic Civilization of Baghdad, including its significant, their discoveries, important learning and key figures of their society.

Geography

In geography, we will be developing our compass, grid referencing and map reading skills. We will use Ordnance Survey maps as well as satellite imaging maps to plan journeys.

PHSE and RE

In RE we will explore Jesus' significance in the 21st century as well as places of worship. In PSHE we will learn about money as well as the body and how our body changes.

English

We will write persuasive letters and information brochures inspired by 'The Paperbag Prince' and being eco-conscious. We will also learn about Jamina's plight to save animals from hunters and write our own adventure narratives based on saving animals. We will continue to test spellings on a Friday and encourage all children to read at home each night.

Maths

This term, we will learn about decimals including place value and multiplying and dividing decimal numbers. We will explore translation, reflection, co-ordinates and symmetry to link to our existing knowledge of shape. We will also be learning about units of measure and how to convert them. We encourage continued revision of times tables.

Art

We will explore sculptures from around the world and will use these as inspiration to create sculptures inspired by the human form and everyday objects. We will appraise our work.

Music

In music we will appraise and compare modern music and Islamic music. We will also be learning 'Dancing in the Street'.

Computing

We will look at how information is presented on the internet. We will create podcasts based on things we are 'experts' in and create marketing campaigns to advertise them.
