Curriculum

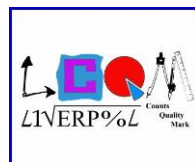
Our creative curriculum topic for this half term is '**Into the Unknown**' Please see our topic web to see all of the exciting things we have planned!

We'd love our children to practise their times tables at home. The children have to take a times table test at the end of the year which will include all tables up to 12 x 12. Every child has a Times Table Rockstars login to help with this. There will be more info to follow on this very soon.
