Please find detailed below, all relevant information about school reopening on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> September. We have been very busy preparing school for Monday and Staff are very much looking forward to welcoming your little people back to their school home for the next chapter of their primary school journey.

Firstly, following the email sent by our school office yesterday regarding up to date payments on Parent Pay, I would like to take the opportunity to reassure you that we understand the financial situation many of you are facing and I would like to remind you that we will support you in any way we can. Key points for September 2022:

Start of the school day-

- Children from Y1-6 will return to school on Monday 5th September
- Pupils in Nursery and Reception will have a staggered return; parents/carers have been informed individually of start dates
- The school gates will open at 8.45am and all children need to be in school for registration by 8.55am
- Being on time for school is key for all children, we ask that every effort is made for your children to arrive on time between 8.45am-8.55am
- If your child is late you must accompany your child into the school office in order to sign them into school

• NB: St Michael's Road and the surrounding area is still affected by the water supply work, there will be minimal availability for parking and there is likely to be congestion. Please consider parking safely further from school and walking to and from the school grounds.

### End of school day-

- All children will finish school at 3.15pm. There will no longer be staggered pick up times
- Pick up areas for each year group are located close to classroom, staff will be available to direct you on Monday if you are unsure
- It is important you vacate the yard when you have collected your child as we have after school provision waiting to use our outdoor areas
- NB: Parents can provide written permission for pupils in Y5 and 6 to walk 'home alone' if required.

#### Uniform/ PE Kits

Please ensure your child returns to school in their school uniform, this includes school shoes not trainers. Your child's class teacher will let you know the timetabled day for P.E. within the first full week via Class Dojo. On this day, children are required to come to school in jogging bottoms/ shorts and a top, preferably dark coloured bottoms and a white T shirt/school jumper. You do not need to buy new clothing for this; please use what you have that is appropriate.

#### Events / Parent's Evenings

Parent/Carer weeks will take place in October. This will be a short session for you to chat with your child's class teacher about how they have settled into their new year group. Further details to follow.

#### Breakfast club/After school club-Haven
