Curriculum

Maths

This term the children will be learning about numbers 0-5. They will begin to identify and count numbers, through songs, games, and Numberblocks.



Phonics

This term the children will be exploring Phase One phonics. We will be learning to hear and identify sounds in our environment and discover the different sounds musical instruments make. The children will also learn to use their bodies to explore body percussion and learn about Rhythm and rhyme.



As a school we follow the Monster Phonics scheme.

P.E

This term we have P.E. on **Thursdays**. we ask that you ensure that your child is wearing either trainers or pumps and comfy clothing .

Home reading

This term we want to introduce children to a love of reading. In a few weeks, your child will bring home a book bag with a reading record and a book to explore. We will send out reading books for you to read with your child on a **Friday**. Book bags need to be returned by to school by **Wednesday**.

Forest school

This term the children will be introduced to Forest School. We will have Forest School on **Fridays**. We ask that you ensure your child has a waterproof coat, trousers or an all-in-one with them and a pair of Wellingtons.



Lunch

Can we please ask that when preparing your child's packed lunch, it contains a well balanced healthy lunch. Consisting of 4/ 5 items : a sandwich or substitute sandwich, a piece of fruit, a yoghurt and two alternative snacks – one savory ie. crisp , crackers etc and one sweet snack – a cake, a biscuit or one chocolate snack.
