Understanding the World

This term the children will be investigating different materials, we will be exploring how to adapt materials. We will also begin to recycle materials different materials. We will also look at different types forces and how they work.

Personal, Social and Emotional development

The children will continue to develop purposeful friendships, through key groups' times and sharing experiences with other children during continuous provision.

Physical Development

The children will continue to work on their gross motor skills, using their large muscles. We will add more opportunities for the children to explore their fine motor skills. This term our P.e. focus will be movement/ dance.



Literacy

This term we will be looking at books about traditional tales. We will look at different characters and story scenes as the children develop their own story lines. We will continue to explore phase one phonics.



Mathematics

This term we will be looking at numbers 5-10. We will be looking at the patterns in numbers and begin to count beyond ten. The children will also be encouraged to represent numbers by making marks or number formations and begin to solve their own number sums.



Expressive arts and design

This term the children will explore different musical instruments. They will also be designing their own porridge and making bread. We will also look at creating homes for our characters from our traditional tales.



Outdoor learning

The children will explore the natural world as they explore the wild garden. The children will also be encouraged to take part in outdoor games to support their gross motor, fine motor and social skills.
