This term we will focus on hybrid texts that persuade and inform. We will develop understanding of modal verbs, adverbs for possibility and persuasive devices. In reading we will access a range of fiction, non-fiction and poetry that relates to other areas of our curriculum and develop vocabulary, inference, explanation and retrieval skills.

Science

Our studies will focus on 'classifying living things', which will involve learning the major classification kingdoms as well as sorting and classifying micro-organisms, plants and animals.

Maths

This term we will revise our understanding of the following areas of *maths* from Year 5, as well as introducing the newer concepts from the Year 6 curriculum. We will look over: place value; using mathematical vocabulary; addition and subtraction; multiplication and division; algebraic equations, BODMAS and measures including time.

Year 6 will have regular access to problem solving and reasoning questions alongside these subject areas.

PE

This half term, Year 6 will develop their balance, agility and control. They will learn gymnastic sequences, mirror sequences, take part in paired work and use the apparatus. We will also continue our weekly swimming.



Computing

We will be learning coding using Espresso, developing our knowledge of more complex variables as well as how to manipulate object properties to create games and apps. We will use our iPads across the curriculum!
