

**Science**

We will investigate the properties of different types of rocks and soils, and group them. We will find out how fossils are formed.

**History**

We will look at the changes as people developed from Stone Age to Iron Age in early Britain.

**Music**

We will be starting our ukulele lessons this term. As well as learning the names of different strings, we will learn about the length of notes.

**PSHEE**

We explore life in modern day Britain, understanding what is a diverse society and talk about why it is important to be respectful.

**English**

Our key Pathways to Writing text is 'Stone Age Boy' by Satoshi Kitamura. In this book a boy from modern times falls back to the stone age. We will explore the structure and vocabulary of the book, write and punctuate conversations between characters, write diary entries and eventually write a historical story from the boy's point of view.

## We will Rock You

**Maths**

We continue to build our fast recall of times tables, doubling the two times table to learn the four times table, and then the eight times table. We will learn about fractions, learn how many of each fraction makes a whole, place fractions on a numberline, and use diagrams to find equivalent fractions.

**PE**

This is our term for swimming lessons. 3M will swim on Fridays before half term, 3B children will go after the half term holiday.

**Art**

In our 'Famous Buildings' topic we will be inspired by different buildings round the world before designing one to meet a design brief.

**Computing**

We continue to use coding to create and control animations. We talk about debugging code, and encourage the children to predict and then investigate what they are coding.

**Religious education**

We will be exploring the question 'Why is the Bible important for Christians today?' We will give examples of how and suggest reasons why Christians use the Bible today.
