Art

The Children will be learning about colour creations. We will be looking at colours and objects associated with them, primary and secondary colours and how we can create them, creating different shades of colours and producing art work

based on Kandinsky.

Music

In music this term our song is 'Hey You' in which the children will learn about the differences between pulse, rhythm and pitch and to learn how to rap and enjoy it in its original form!

Science

The children will be learning about types of animals. Year 1 Spring 1

Maths
