We will be learning about how people earn a living, different types of jobs, and comparing our lives with the lives of children who have to undertake paid work.

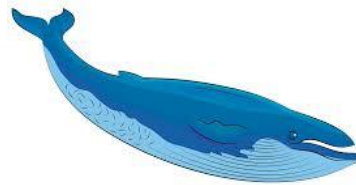
### PSHEE

### Maths

We continue to use our new scheme 'Maths No Problem'. Topics this half term include multiplication and division, including multiplying 2-digit numbers by a single digit number by partitioning the 2-digit number. We will also be measuring length, weight and volume and changing measurements from one unit to another.

### Design and Technology
