Communication and Language

This term the children will be encouraged to share their ideas through sharing news and during circle time. The children will use their fast-growing vocabulary skills to tell stories and express themselves.



Personal, Social and Emotional development

The children will continue to develop purposeful friendships, through key group times and within the continuous provision. The children will also develop their understanding of eating well balanced meals.



Physical Development

This term the children will develop their skills in preparation for sports day. The children will develop their throwing skills, running skills, stopping skills and negotiating space skills.



Understanding the World

This term the children will be learning about different occupations. We will learn about different people who can help us, when we need some help in an emergency and in a non-emergency. The children will be visited by a host of visitors



Topic: Who are you going to call?
Term: Summer 1



Literacy

This term we will be looking at the book 'You can't call an elephant in an emergency'. The children will continue to learn how stories are sequenced and how to innovate new characters. This term we will be looking at phase two Monster Phonics.



Expressive arts and design

This term the children will be expressive as they learn to move to different types of music. The children will also explore art from Piet Mondrian, as they become mini artists.



Outdoor learning

The children will explore the natural world as they explore the wild garden. The children will also be encouraged to take part in games, phonics, maths and physical development.

Mathematics

This term the children will be exploring different types of measurements. We will be looking at measuring liquids using capacity. We will use blocks to investigate length, and explore weight using scales.
