Communication and Language

This term the children will continue to be encouraged to share their ideas through sharing news and during circle time. The children will use their fast-growing vocabulary skills to tell stories to themselves.



Personal, Social and Emotional development

The children will continue to develop purposeful friendships, through key group times and within the continuous provision. The children will also develop their understanding of eating well balanced meals.



Physical Development

This term the children will continue to develop their skills in preparation for sports day. The children will develop their throwing skills, running skills, stopping skills and negotiating space skills.



Understanding the World

This term the children will be learning about holidays, and different ways to travel around. We will have a travel agent for the children to explore different places, holidays and diverse cultures.

Literacy

This term we will be looking at the book 'What the Ladybird heard on'. The children will continue to learn how stories are sequenced. This term we will be looking at phase 2 Monster Phonics and will continue Aspect 1 phonics.
