

Art.

This term we will be looking at mark making and studying the Artist Paul Klee. We will be creating pictures in the style Klee using various mark making techniques.



Music

In music this term the children will be using their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes. They will be exploring how to perform poetry which will link in with English!

This term our topic is 'Who is a Christian and what do they believe?'

Phonics

In phonics this half term we will be learning lots of new graphemes and continuing to develop our phonics skills using Monster Phonics.

Science

The children will be learning about the changing seasons. We will be observing changes across the four seasons. We will be describing what type of weather is associated with the different seasons and how the length of the days varies in the seasons.



Geography

Our topic this term is 'Arctic Adventures'. We will be developing our map skills and looking at animals that live in these cold areas. We will be comparing hot and cold places and delving deep into the Arctic!

PHSEE

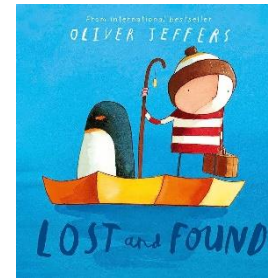
This term we will be looking at 'Me and My Relationships'. The children will be exploring what makes them special and who their special people are, who can help them and their feelings.
