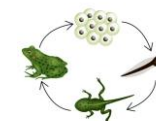
Geography

Science

We will be exploring numbers to 100 including; counting to 100 through different steps, including counting up in tens and comparing numbers using our place-value knowledge.

PSHE and R.E

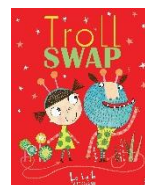
Our PSHE topic is 'Me and my relationships' we will talk about our feelings and how to be a good friend.

English

This half term we will be using the story 'Troll Swap' by Leigh Hodgkinson. The children will make predictions based on what they already know about a story. They will also be doing different types of writing – letters, diary entries etc. before writing their own version of the story using expanded noun phrases and the conjunctions 'and' and 'because'. Our Whole class reading text is 'Trolls go home' by Alan MacDonald.
