Homework

English

Our writing unit for the second spring half term is based on the text 'Major Dizzy, Major Glad' we will be using this stimulus to help us write a diary entry. Phonics

We will continue with daily phonics sessions, following our monster phonics scheme. Re-capping these sounds; **kn**, **gn**, **wr**, **le**, **el**, **il** and **al**. Reading

We will also do paired reading three times per week using books linked to sounds we have learnt in class and developing our comprehension skills.

Art

During our art unit this term we will be exploring 'Earth Art'.

Children will be able to use Shape, form and space to create artwork that is unique to them.

History

This term, children will explore the history of the Titanic. Year 2 will use their knowledge of chronology to order events on a timeline.

As well as learning the difference between primary and secondary source.
