Dear Parents/Carers,

As a part of your child's education at St Michael in the Hamlet, we promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education programme. PSHE education is the curriculum subject that gives children the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live safe, healthy, productive lives and meet their full potential.

I am writing to let you know that, over the next term, starting on Tuesday 14th April 2026, your child's class will be taking part in lessons which will focus on the relationships and sex education (RSE) aspect of this programme. Lessons in Year 1 will consider the life cycle of animals and humans, including how they grow and change as they get older. They are exploring the parts of their bodies that stay the same, as well as the differences between boys and girls. They are also reflecting on the changes that have happened in their own lives.

PSHE education is taught throughout the school in every year group and is monitored and reviewed regularly by the staff and governing body. Please visit the school's website for more detail about our PSHE curriculum.
